



## Leptospermum laevigatum

### Coastal Tea Tree

This is a large, bushy shrub or small, twisted tree with grey-green, oval-shaped foliage and small white flowers in spring or early summer.

#### Uses

It has been used extensively in coastal areas as a wind brea.

#### Preferred Position & Soil

It is a hardy shrub for moist soils in a range of climates and prefer full sun or part shade. It is tolerant of salt spray making it particularly useful in coastal areas.
