Brachychiton populneus **KURRAJONG**

For feature foliage it is difficult to go past this variety. Beautiful green foliage and red stems, it is perfect as a single specimen or multiple planting if you have the space. An evergreen tree with a wide canopy once established, it grows 8-12m tall.



Arbutus unedo **IRISH STRAWBERRY TREE**

A smaller tree for smaller spaces, without any compromise on attractiveness. This is a beautiful addition to any garden. An evergreen tree, growing 4-8m tall, it works wonderfully well layered in the garden as a backdrop to smaller shrubs and plants.



Eucalyptus sideroxylon rosea

RED-FLOWERING IRONBARK

For fascinating bark, this is a doozy. An iconic Australian look with crusty dark bark peeling away from a smooth trunk, this feature is best with space as it can grow between 12-20m tall. Best leave this selection for acreage parks and gardens



Pyrus calleryana 'Cleveland Select'

CLEVELAND SELECT ORNAMENTAL PEAR

Pyrus is always a popular selection and Cleveland Select is a great option for many landscaping uses. A deciduous tree growing 8-12m tall, it can be used as a striking feature tree or multiple planted as a group. Makes a fantastic creative screening option along a fenceline or driveway.



Ginkgo biloba

MAIDENHAIR TREE

The oldest tree recorded in the world, the Ginkgo has one of the best looking leaves and foliage of any tree going around! Deciduous and growing 12-20m tall, its beautiful open structure and soft foliage makes a commanding shade tree.



Magnolia grandiflora 'Kay Parris'

KAY PARRIS MAGNOLIA (EVERGREEN)

One of the smaller growing Magnolia grandiflora varieties growing between 4-8m tall, this beautiful tree has so much going for it - wide white open flowers and glossy green leaves with a wavy edge it is suitable as a feature and as a creative hedge.
