### **Banksia integrifolia** **COASTAL BANKSIA**

A lovely and distinctive native. It has long green leaves with a silver underside and pale yellow cylindrical flowers from summer to winter. We have this tree in a range of sizes available now, from 30cm, 40cm through to 150 litre bags.



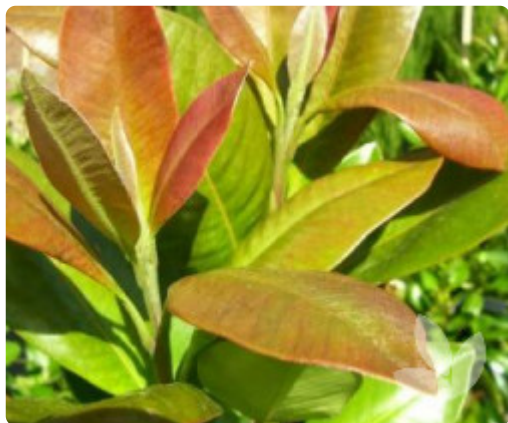
### **Magnolia grandiflora 'Little Gem'** **LITTLE GEM MAGNOLIA (EVERGREEN)**

Growing 6m tall x 3m wide, this is a very popular tree for compactness and density. A great selection for a two tone screen, as the leaves are glossy deep green with a furry brown underside.
