LAVENDER-TWIGGED BOX ELDER, PURPLE LEAF BOX ELDER (MAPLE)

This hardy box elder has purple branches and showy reddish-violet flowers that hang from branches. Foliage starts out copper-green in colour, becoming a deeper green as it ages. Growth is golden yellow in autumn. Its pendulous clusters of flowers gives it an impressive look as a single garden specimen. Has an upright habit and pyramidal form.

Makes a lovely eye-catching feature tree many times throughout the year based on maple-shaped foliage colour and flowers.

Adaptable to a wide range of climates and conditions but prefers a well-drained soil.
