










<b>Tree</b>	 <p><b>Acer rubrum 'Bowhall'</b> </p>
<b>Description</b>	This is a compact, narrow growing cultivar with mid to dark green foliage. Leaves have three-to-five-lobed leaves with light green petioles and veins, lighter grey-green on the underside. Foliage turns yellowish-red to orange in autumn.
<b>Foliage</b>	 Deciduous
<b>Form</b>	 Conical
<b>Mature Size</b>	10 x 5m
<b>Uses</b>	This tree is excellent as a street tree or planted in gardens where lateral space is limited. Can screen if you have the space.
