










<b>Tree</b>	 <p><b>Banksia spinulosa 'Honey Pot'</b> HAIRPIN BANKSIA</p>
<b>Description</b>	A great low growing shrub that produces stunning honey coloured flowers typical of a banksia. The flowers are borne in autumn to early spring and attract birds and insects. The foliage is thin and green with a dense growth habit.
