


Tree	 <p>Citrus limon 'Lisbon Lemon'</p>
Description	<p>This variety is believed to be the most commonly grown lemon in Australia producing very high quality lemons with a thin skin, good juice and high acidity. Once a year it produces a heavy crop of fruit in mid winter to early spring.</p>

Position & Soil	<p>Prefers sites with well drained soil and likes a regular watering schedule during the first growing season to establish a deep, extensive root system. Trees can be pruned back in winter.</p>
