











Tree	 <p>Corymbia ficifolia 'Baby Orange' GRAFTED FLOWERING GUM</p>
Description	<p>This is a compact and tough Australian native with brilliant flowers in summertime. It produces numerous branches which form a dense canopy. Over the summer months it is covered with striking orange flowers, providing a feast for nectar loving birds. This selection of the common flowering gum was chosen for its bright orange flowers and compact size.</p>

Uses	<p>Grafted flowering gums provide an excellent choice for specimen plantings. They are smaller than natives used historically in the landscape and offer great flowering colour in summer.</p>
Position & Soil	<p>As this variety is grafted onto maculata rootstock, it is very tolerant of sun and most soil conditions.</p>
