<p>Description</p>	<p>Compared to 'Lowanna', 'Toombah' is a much larger tree but full and with good form. It has a spotted trunk that is cream and grey. The foliage is dark green and it forms a dense canopy. Adult leaves are 10 to 20cm long and lanceolate shape. It has small white flowers that are clustered together.</p>
