








<b>Tree</b>	 <p><b>Eucalyptus cinerea 'grafted'</b> ARGYLE APPLE, CANBERRA BLUE GUM</p>
<b>Description</b>	This is a small to medium sized tree with reddish-brown to grey-brown rough bark on the trunk and larger branches. Makes a beautiful landscape specimen, planted singly or in groups. It has distinctive, blue-green aromatic foliage. The creamy yellow flowers are insignificant. It is known by its round grey-blue leaves that often pop up in floral arrangements.

<b>Mature Size</b>	12 x 7m
<b>Uses</b>	This variety makes a nice medium-sized feature tree in small to large gardens due to its distinctive blue-green foliage. Stems are popular in cut flower arrangements.
