










<b>Tree</b>	 <p><b>Eucalyptus cladocalyx 'EUC78'</b> <b>Vintage Red TM</b> </p>
<b>Description</b>	This native tree is described as the first ever red-foliaged Eucalypt. Foliage colour is deep red maturing to purple and grey tones over time. It produces rich dark red stems that are almost black. Bark is smooth and grey.
<b>Foliage</b>	 Evergreen
<b>Form</b>	 Round
<b>Mature Size</b>	6-8 x 3-4m
<b>Uses</b>	This tree responds very well to pruning and will thicken up. Can be kept as a shrub if pruned. Makes an attractive feature tree. Foliage can be used in flower arranging.
<b>Position &amp; Soil</b>	'Vintage Red' prefers a position in full sun to part shade in sandy loam to well-drained clay soils. Tolerates cold and drought.
