










Tree	 <p>Liriodendron tulipifera 'aureamarginatum'</p>
Description	<p>Another tall and handsome tree like Liriodendron tulipulifera but with a yellow rim to its leaves and a more conical shape. Produces the same big, tulip-like single flowers in Spring. Flowers only grow after 7 years or older.</p>
Foliage	<p> Deciduous</p>
Form	<p> Oval</p>
Mature Size	<p>15 x 6m</p>
Uses	<p>Great as a specimen tree in a spacious landscape. Can be used in parks or large gardens where it can grow and flourish to its full potential.</p>
Position & Soil	<p>Prefers a well-drained, fertile, slightly acidic soil in a temperate climate but also tolerates most soils. Enjoys full sun but can occasionally get sun scorched leaves. Tolerates air pollution.</p>
