Description	This is a beautiful little evergreen Magnolia. Its compact, tidy form lends itself well to creating an easily maintained, neat and tidy flowering hedge. Deep green, leathery foliage gives a year-round lush appearance and a display of fragrant, pink blushed, creamy-white flowers and appear in two flushes per year - late winter-spring and again in late summer-autumn.

Uses	These trees grow well as a single specimen or as a perfumed hedge to 4-5m tall.
Position & Soil	They grow best in a well-drained soil and can be lightly pruned in early spring to retain their shape.
