<b>Description</b>	<p>A small growing tree that has leather like thin leaves which are green with silver undersides. An olive that is used as a great table olive.</p>
<b>Foliage</b>	<p> Evergreen</p>
<b>Form</b>	<p> Oval</p>
<b>Mature Size</b>	<p>6 x 3m</p>
<b>Uses</b>	<p>Great in a grove planting if room, otherwise plant it for contrast colour and foliage. Can be potted or planted in small to medium gardens for texture and fruit.</p>
<b>Position &amp; Soil</b>	<p>Olives flourish where there is good drainage and cool winters, with hot dry summers without humidity. Prefers a humus rich soil.</p>
