Description	<p>This small growing tree has leather-like leaves which are green with silver undersides. The black fruit is edible once processed. It is a favourite in Spain for its oil.</p>
Foliage	<p> Evergreen</p>

Mature Size	<p>6 x 3m</p>
Uses	<p>Great in a grove planting if room, otherwise plant it for contrast colour and foliage.</p>
Position & Soil	<p>Olives flourish where there is good drainage and cool winters, with hot dry summers without humidity. Prefers a humus rich soil.</p>
