<b>Description</b>	This small growing tree has leather-like leaves which are green with silver undersides. The black fruit is edible once processed. It is a favourite in Spain for its oil.
<b>Foliage</b>	 Evergreen
<b>Form</b>	 Round
<b>Mature Size</b>	6 x 3m
<b>Uses</b>	Great in a grove planting if room, otherwise plant it for contrast colour and foliage.
<b>Position &amp; Soil</b>	Olives flourish where there is good drainage and cool winters, with hot dry summers without humidity. Prefers a humus rich soil.
