<b>Description</b>	<p>This is a fruiting cherry tree producing heart-shaped reddish/black-skinned sweet cherry suitable for eating and cooking. It is a self-pollinating variety with a semi-upright growth habit that needs a cold winter to produce good fruit.</p>
