









<b>Tree</b>	 <p><b>Prunus salicina 'Wickson'</b> WICKSON JAPANESE PLUM</p>
<b>Description</b>	This variety of Japanese Plum produces large, heart-shaped greenish-yellow fruit. It has very sweet, translucent flesh. Harvest is mid-season. Japanese Plum trees have a wider spread than European Plums and fruit tends to be larger and juicier.

<b>Form</b>	 V-Shaped
<b>Mature Size</b>	5 x 4m
<b>Uses</b>	Fruit is mostly used for eating fresh.
<b>Position &amp; Soil</b>	Prefers a full Sun position in a moist but well-drained soil. Irrigate in dry periods.
