MT FUJI GRAFTED STANDARD
ORNAMENTAL CHERRY

Tree	
Description	A very popular feature tree for small gardens. This deciduous, ornamental cherry develops a spreading flat crown with branches that droop down slightly. A beautiful display of pure white, semi double blossoms cover the tree in early to mid-spring, followed by finely serrated, pale green leaves which darken to mid green over the warmer months. In autumn, foliage turns shades of orange and red.

Form	 Weeping
Mature Size	1.8m graft
Uses	As a grafted tree with horizontal branches that fall slightly and its ability to flower, this tree is highly sought after as a feature specimen.
Position & Soil	While adaptable to many site conditions, this tree prefers a moist, well drained, fertile soil in a sunny or part-shade position.
