



<b>Tree</b>	 <p><b>Viburnum odoratissimum</b> <b>'Coppertop'</b> </p> <p>COPPERTOP SWEET VIBURNUM</p>
<b>Description</b>	<p>This is a new variety to the market of the very popular sweet viburnum where leaves are more slender in shape and more glossy. A visual point of difference is in the darker colour of its foliage - almost chocolate - and this is very noticeable in new spring growth. It is dense and compact making it perfect for hedging. In spring it produces small white flowers that are fragrant and butterfly-attracting.</p>
