

Malus domestica 'Echtermeyer' (weeping standard)



ECHTERMAYER WEEPING CRAB APPLE

This is a hardy, low and wide-spreading, deciduous, ornamental tree with a lovely weeping habit. It bears deep red buds and rosy-red flowers in spring which turn to purplish-red small fruits. It makes a knock-out specimen tree in a small landscape.

As a weeping form of an ornamental Apple, it works well as a feature tree in any landscape.

Prefers a well-drained, fertile soil in a mild to cool climate. They are considered very frost hardy. They appreciate an annual feed with a balanced, slow-release fertiliser.
