

## Prunus persica 'Red Noonan'



### RED NOONAN DWARF PEACH

Red Noonan is a white-fleshed, free-stone peach variety, producing medium-sized, round juicy fruit with a deep red and cream skin.

This variety is good for eating and drying. As a small-growing form, this is a good variety for home gardens.

Plant in a humus-rich, well-drained soil in a sunny position. Plant the bud union above the soil level and water in well keeping the soil moist until tree is established. Fertiliser should be applied at the time of planting and again after the appearance of new growth. Pruning the tree annually will ensure new growth and fruit the following year.
